

Basic Rawhide Rattle Workshop

Saturday and Sunday September 11th and September 12th

Windsong Healing Arts is holding a basic rawhide rattle workshop. In this basic workshop you will learn to create a rawhide rattle with a soft sound for use in shamanic practice. Pauline Micciche will facilitate the workshop as you learn how to prepare the head of the rattle, attach the handle, and decorate your creation. Sound making materials will be primarily from plants grown in the earth. The wooden handles are made from fallen branches or have been harvested from the tree to improve its growth. Participants will design the decoration for their rattle, asking guidance from the spirits using either meditation or a shamanic journey. Basic paints and feathers will be provided and you may bring anything else you wish to use for decoration. The price of the workshop is \$55.00 and includes everything needed to finish your rawhide rattle. Light snacks as well as coffee, tea, and water are provided.
